## **Red Kite seeks two new members to join its Board**

Local housing association Red Kite Community Housing is looking for two new members to join its Board - a tenant member, and a Chair of the Board's Audit & Risk Committee. The Red Kite Board has overall responsibility for the organisation's success and ensures compliance with all legal and regulatory obligations by directing and supervising the Red Kite Group's affairs.

Noreen Adams, Red Kite's Head of Governance, said:

"Our tenants and leaseholders take an active role in everything that we do. This is an enormously exciting time to be joining our Board. We have the group structure and financial resources in place to deliver some exciting plans and are seeking people that can bring experience, leadership, challenge and support to help drive us and to work with us to realise our goals."

Red Kite is particularly interested in attracting a range of applicants to maintain a strong skills mix and diversity within its Board. Applicants offering any of the following will be particularly welcomed:

The estimated time commitment is around three days per month, and both positions are paid - the tenant Board member will receive £6,000 a year, and the Audit & Risk Committee Chair will receive £9,500 a year.

Training and mentoring will be offered, and for those new to the housing sector, the induction programme will include training on the housing sector regulatory environment.
