Red Kite Roadshow helps connect residents with local support

Community event attracts 185 residents for afternoon of advice, activities and conversation

Red Kite Community Housing welcomed 185 local residents to its Roadshow event on Wednesday 5th August, bringing together tenants, community organisations and local services for an afternoon of support, information and family activities.

The event gave residents the opportunity to speak directly with Red Kite teams, ask questions, share feedback and learn more about the services and support available in their community. It also helped connect people with a range of local organisations offering advice and assistance.

Families enjoyed free activities including a bouncy castle and face painting, while visitors of all ages were treated to free ice creams.

Representatives from several partner organisations attended the event, including Thames Valley Police, Women's Aid, the Rape and Sexual Abuse Support Service (RSASS), Maximus, Buckinghamshire Council's Helping Hand and Antisocial Behaviour teams, and Twenty11.

The Roadshow also provided an opportunity for Red Kite to introduce its new Tenant Question Time sessions, encourage tenants to become members ahead of its Annual General Meeting, and answer questions about the support and services it provides.

Laura, Tenant Engagement Manager at Red Kite Community Housing, said:

"It was fantastic to see so many people come along and take part in the Roadshow. Events like this give us the chance to have meaningful conversations with residents, understand what's important to them and help connect them with the support available in their community."

The housing association said the event demonstrated the value of bringing local organisations and residents together, while creating opportunities to listen to feedback and strengthen community connections.
