Red Kite Community Housing sponsors Downley Skip Day

On Wednesday 25th June, residents of the Disraeli ward in Downley came together for a successful community clean-up initiative, Downley Skip Day, an event sponsored by Red Kite Community Housing.

Spearheaded by Maz Hussain, Buckinghamshire Councillor for Disraeli, the event was made possible thanks to Red Kite's Environmental Improvement Group who secured funding for skips to be placed across the ward.

The initiative was designed to help Red Kite tenants and other local residents dispose of bulky household waste responsibly, addressing the ongoing issue of fly-tipping in the area.

Skips were stationed at key locations including Coates Lane Car Park, Mendip Way, Cumbrian Way, Brecon Way, and Cotswold Way. The event ran from 10am to 3pm, with clear guidelines provided to ensure only appropriate household waste was disposed of.

After the event, Councillor Hussain took to Facebook to say:

"We had a very successful 'Skip Day' in Disraeli and it was great to see so many residents making use of the free skips.

"I was able to speak to many of you and wonderful to hear how happy you were about this initiative.

"A big thank you to Red Kite Community Housing for their support and funding, and to everyone who joined in the litter-picking. Let's keep Disraeli clean together!"
